**DECLARATION OF THOMAS M. BALUN REGARDING
STATEMENT OF PLANNED COMPLIANCE**

I, Thomas M. Balun, being of sound mind and full age, do hereby declare as follows:

1. I am the CEO of TV Max, Inc., d/b/a Wavevision (“TV Max”).
2. On June 25, 2013, the FCC issued a Notice of Apparent Liability for Forfeiture and Order (“NAL”) in the above-captioned matter. This declaration is submitted in response to the directive contained in Paragraph 19 of the NAL and sets forth the steps that will be taken to achieve compliance with the requirements of Section 325 of the Act and Section 76.64 of the FCC’s Rules.
3. In order to cease using the fiber owned by Broadband Fiber, LLC to deliver six local broadcast channels (KTXH(TV), KRIV(TV), KXLN-DT, KFTH-DT, KPRC-TV and KTRK-TV) to the private cable subscribers served by Broadband Ventures Six, LLC, Broadband Ventures Six, LLC is taking the following actions:

- a. Broadband Ventures Six, LLC will convert its private cable customers to DISH Network. Broadband Ventures Six, LLC, a Private Cable Operator, has commenced negotiations with representatives of DISH Network to convert all of its customers through a programming agreement with DISH Network. Broadband Ventures Six, LLC provides video service to viewers in approximately 7,000 apartment units, 3,000 of which are retail subscribers and approximately 4,000 viewers are served under approximately 25 bulk contracts.
 - b. On or before August 30, 2013, Broadband Ventures Six, LLC will notify its subscribers that it will no longer be carrying network programming specified above that is offered in the private cable system.
 - c. The projected cost of conversion to DISH is estimated at [REDACTED] per household. The total cost of conversion of 7,000 viewers is estimated at [REDACTED]. Because these funds are not available to Broadband Ventures Six, LLC, they will have to be borrowed.
 - d. While the conversion could, under ideal circumstances, be completed in approximately 120 days, due to property access requirements complete conversion is expected to be delayed. Management estimates that the conversion will be completed by December 31, 2013.
4. After completion of the conversion, it will no longer be necessary for Broadband Ventures Six, LLC to lease from Broadband Fiber, LLC dark fiber for the purpose of carrying network content.

5. The above-described plan, to be undertaken at great cost to Broadband Ventures Six, LLC, will most efficiently achieve the objectives of the FCC while, at the


