It was the obvious intention of Congress, and it is the expectation of people who are blind or visually impaired across America, that accessible TVs and TV-like equipment will be readily and regularly available at commercial retail stores.

Being visually-impaired, I am absolutely opposed to the consumer electronics lobby's proposed gutting of one of the most popular and important parts of the CVAA.
