



CBI submitted its reply comments through the Commission’s ECFS filing interface and received confirmation number: 201382814393. In reading the confirmation notice, CBI realized that its reply comments contained links which might cause the submission to be rejected as the confirmation contained, “However, your filing will be rejected by ECFS if it contains macros, passwords, redlining, read-only formatting, a virus, or automated links to other documents.”

Out of an abundance of caution, CBI is submitting its reply comments a second time with the links removed. In deleting the links, CBI noticed some minor typographical errors which have been corrected in the version being submitted at this time. Both submissions are being timely filed. In the event that the ECFS does not reject CBI’s initial filing, CBI requests that this filing be used instead and the first submission be discarded.
