I protested and he then said he could take the AMX card if I agreed to a 6 month service agreement it would be \$120. I protested and it was lowered to \$99.00 and I was then connected to another party where I was to make a phone conformation There is more but not enough here for report .Please...Google " PCwizards phone call"" and see this scam has been running for sometime. I have names and phone #s I canceled my AMX card and they only tried to take the \$99 dollars not take to limit. the original call ID said New York, came @ 4:13 July 29 and when I called back the # was not in service. PCwizards did give me phone # and there are people there they gave me an address of 9350 s Cimarron Rd. #4104 Las Vegas. Google st. view shows it to be a large apartment complex Reach me at 760 948 4953. I have been sick about this and feel like a fool, all these strong accented asians have very American sounding names Edward Thompsos Steve Parker, most likly aliases. A few years back I put my ph # on the do not call list but lately have been getting many nuisance calls. I am sure that the original call coming in within minutes of using the computer was a coincidence but my mind made a connection. I see this as a foreign based criminal syndacate operating over the phone and internet, it could be that they are gathering peoples info and at thier chosen time, after gathering enough personal financial information they could move millions overseas and be gone.
