Yesterday, the undersigned, together with Kevin Hess, Senior Vice President - Government & Regulatory Affairs, and Robert Debroux, Director - Federal Affairs & Public Policy, of TDS Telecommunications Corp. (“TDS Telecom”), participated in a series of meetings to discuss the status of TDS Telecom’s Petition for Limited Waiver that was filed in the above-referenced proceedings.<sup>1</sup>

The meetings were with Julie Veach, Deena Shetler, and Jamie Susskind of the Wireline Competition Bureau; and then with each of Rebekah Goodheart, Legal Advisor to Interim Chairman Clyburn; Priscilla Argeris, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Rosenworcel; and Nick Degani, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Pai. In each meeting, TDS Telecom emphasized the importance of its Petition to the delivery of robust broadband services to its customers. TDS Telecom also reiterated the limited scope of the relief sought by its Petition.
