
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On August 13, 2013, Gina Perini of SMS/800, Inc., Ann Berkowitz of Verizon, and I met with Priscilla Delgado Argeris of Commissioner Rosenworcel's office to discuss certain issues related to the SMS/800 Inc.'s Petition To Change the Composition of SMS/800, Inc. (the "Petition"), filed in the above-captioned dockets on September 13, 2012.

During the meeting, we discussed the historical context in which the Petition was filed and why the proposed transfer of tariffing responsibility, expanded industry representation on the board of SMS/800, Inc., and authorization of SMS/800, Inc. to act as neutral administrator of the SMS/800 database would serve the public interest.
