Dear Ms. Dortch:

Allied Wireless Communications Corporation and Atlantic Tele-Network, Inc. (collectively, "ATN") hereby provide this supplemental response to the June 5, 2013, Information and Discovery Request from the Federal Communications Commission in the above-referenced docket.¹ The enclosed encrypted disc contains the privilege log for ATN's initial and supplemental productions (the "Privilege Log"). The Privilege Log is designated as "Highly Confidential" per the Second Protective Order.²

Pursuant to the procedures set forth in the Information Request and the Protective Orders, we are submitting to the Office of the Secretary a copy of this disc as well as two copies of the filing in hardcopy. An equivalent set of copies is being delivered to Scott Patrick of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau's Mobility Division. The public version of this letter, but not the Privilege Log, is being filed through the Commission's Electronic Comment Filing System.

Each row of the Privilege Log represents a document to which ATN claims privilege. Unless privilege is claimed only for a redacted portion of a previously produced document, as indicated in the Privilege Log, ATN claims privilege for the entire document.

ATN has made an effort to ensure that none of the contents of the Privilege Log are privileged themselves under the attorney-client privilege or attorney work product doctrine or any other applicable privilege. To the extent that any privileged material may have been inadvertently produced in the
