Dear Ms. Monteith,

On July 16, 2013, Sprint Corporation (“Sprint”) filed a Petition for Temporary Limited Waiver of the Federal Communications Commission’s (“Commission”) speed-of-answer requirements governing the provision of IP Relay service. On August 2, 2013, the Commission granted a short-term waiver for August 1st thru August 12th and stated that it would give full consideration to Sprint’s waiver as originally requested from July 7, 2013 thru November 7, 2013.

In light of subsequent developments, Sprint no longer seeks a waiver beyond the one the Commission has already granted covering the period of August 1st thru August 12, 2013. Sprint, therefore, respectfully requests that its petition for a waiver of the IP Relay speed-of-answer requirements beyond August 12, 2013 be withdrawn.
