

Dear Mr. Nixon:

We are in receipt of the materials you sent us as filings under the above docket number on March 20, 2012, March 28, 2012, and April 2, 2012.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code Section 1.4(d) permits the Commission to decline to accept a document for filing when upon inspection, the Commission is of the opinion that the submittal does not comply with the regulations. Your materials cannot be considered as Exceptions to the Initial Decision served on December 23, 2011, because they are untimely. The last day to file Exceptions to the Initial Decision was January 12, 2012.
