Comment round for FCC ET Docket No. 013-84 and ET Docket No. 03-137

1. My name is Susan Stewart. My address is 2624 Lakewood Place, Westlake Village, CA 91361.
2. I am a registered nurse.
3. I feel that the FCC RF safety guidelines should be updated to protect the public's health and safety as well as prevent the real potential for privacy infringement and sabotage of our nation's electricity and communications' grid. The current safety guidelines are based on inappropriate (thermal) data prior to 1996, before the explosion of wireless technology. Testimony from non-industry experts is essential to end up with the real picture that is needed to set up current guidelines. While it may seem reasonable to want to avoid "undue burden on industry", they have way over-stated benefits and way under-stated risks with this technology. If our leaders had not been so eager to believe the spin (or take the "donations") of the tobacco lobby and avoid burdening them with "undue" regulation, maybe a few million lives could have been saved, along with the lost productivity of their lives and costs to the healthcare system.
4. It is unreasonable for you to expect such expert testimony from the general public as we do not have the backgrounds or finances required. Non-industry experts are required as well as a direct request of the EPA to used its taxpayer-funded resources and experts (National Risk Management Research Lab) to conduct the cost analysis asked for in this proceeding.

5. A moratorium needs to be placed on sales of new spectrum, transmitting utility meter installation, and installation of additional base stations for wireless service while biologically-based safety limits are being developed.
