

We're sending this letter to notify you that your FCC Form 471 application and/or certification was received or postmarked AFTER the deadline for an application to be considered as filed within the window. TO REQUEST A WAIVER OF THE FILING WINDOW DEADLINE:

If you missed the FCC Form 471 filing window deadline and wish to request a waiver, you may file a waiver request with the FCC. You should refer to CC Docket No. 02-6 on the first page of your waiver request. We strongly recommend that you review "Appeals" posted in the Reference Area of the SLD section of the USAC website for electronic filing options and additional information on waiver requests.

TO APPEAL THIS DECISION:

If you disagree with the decision indicated in this letter - for example, if you believe that you postmarked your FCC Form 471 on or before the filing window deadline - you have the option of filing an appeal with USAC or with the FCC.

If you wish to appeal to USAC, your appeal must be received by USAC or postmarked within 60 days of the date of this letter. Failure to meet this requirement will result in automatic dismissal of your appeal. In your letter of appeal:

1. Include the name, address, telephone number, fax number, and email address for the person who can most readily discuss this appeal with us.
2. State outright that your letter is an appeal. Include the following to identify the decision letter and the decision you are appealing:
