Dear Ms. Dortch:

Bloomberg, LP (“Bloomberg”), by its attorneys, respectfully requests that the Commission include its decision in the above-referenced matter on its agenda for its scheduled September 26, 2013 open meeting.

The Media Bureau’s last decision in this matter was released on August 14, 2012, over a year ago. *Bloomberg v. Comcast*, 27 FCC Rcd. 9488 (2012). The arguments in this matter are well known and the pleading cycle ended more than ten months ago. The duration of the news neighborhood condition is seven years and less than four and a half years remain before it expires under the provisions of the Comcast-NBCU Merger Order.

A Memorandum Opinion and Order has been on the Commission’s Items on Circulation since January 29, 2013. Even if the Commission decides this matter at its September open meeting, it will have been on circulation for eight months. On June 27, 2013, Bloomberg requested action on this item. More than two months has passed since that letter was filed. Therefore, Bloomberg requests that the matter be included on the agenda for the Commission’s September 26, 2013 open meeting.
