1. My name is Terilynn Langsev . My address is 965 Village Lane Santa Barbara California.
2. I am a retired City Planner. I request that that the FCC should make a direct request to the EPA to use its taxpayer-funded resources and experts present at its National Risk Management Research Laboratory to conduct all of the cost analyses it has asked for in this proceeding regarding the study of effects of RF radiation on human cells and tissues beyond thermal effects.
3. The FCC that has a duty under *Scenic Hudson* to create a complete record and to consider seriously my comments and experience in order to fulfill its obligation to represent the public interest.
4. It is in the best interest of all human beings and all life that the FCC reevaluate and change the safety guidelines.
5. I personally have been struggling with effects of RF exposure since the proliferation of wireless technology and increased power of cell phone towers and transmissions. I experience adverse effects to my health way beyond heating up. I experience heart palpitations, muscle weakness. Severe ice pick to the head head aches, cogitative disorientation, the feeling of electricity running through my body, nervous system hyper stimulation, sleep problems, depression and anxiety during and after exposure to RF frequencies. It is getting increasingly difficult to live in the current environment.

6. In addition to my own personal experience and the similar experience of a number of people I know, there are credible scientific studies that show the harm to human cells and the diminishing ability of cells to replicate in a healthy way in the presence of RF exposure.

7. The advent of wireless technology is advancing far more rapidly than the science and effects of the exposure for all living things can be determined. There fore this technology boom is a huge experiment with the human biology and life it self.

8. We, the United States of America, should be on the forefront of research and understanding of this potential effects and potential harm to humans and all life.
