Dear Ms. De La Torre:

T C Telecom LLC ("T C Telecom") files this letter to notify the Commission that it agrees to accept the terms and conditions for a waiver of the benchmark rate applicable to Cuba set forth in the FCC's April 8, 2011 *Memorandum Opinion and Order* in the above-captioned docket.<sup>1</sup> This waiver permits a per minute settlement rate of up to \$0.84 for the provision of direct services between the United States and Cuba. T C Telecom respectfully requests that the FCC, consistent with the process set forth in paragraph 33 of the *Memorandum Opinion and Order*, reflect T C Telecom's acceptance of the conditions and extend the waiver to it in an "Informative" as part of its Public Notice of actions taken.
