Dear Ms. Dortch:

On September 10, 2013, Mark Jarman, President of Inovonics Wireless Corporation ("Inovonics"), as well as the undersigned and Henry Goldberg of this firm, counsel for Inovonics, met with the following individuals from the Office of Engineering and Technology: Julius Knapp, Rashmi Doshi, Karen Rackley, Mark Settle, Hugh Van Tuyl, and Steven Jones.

The meeting primarily addressed proposed changes to the Section 15.31 measurement standards, as set out in ET Docket No. 13-44. Consistent with Inovonics' filings in the proceeding,<sup>1</sup> Mr. Jarman detailed the high cost to consumers, manufacturers and test labs if the Commission were to adopt the 2009 ANSI measurement standard.

Inovonics additionally updated the staff on the Progeny/Part 15 matter, WT Docket No. 11-49, and in particular its discussions with Progeny/NextNav regarding potential joint testing between the two parties, and the on-going need for the Commission to monitor Progeny's deployment and its impact on unlicensed users.
