**STREAMLINED FINANCIAL HARDSHIP WAIVER CERTIFICATION**

Rancho Palos Verdes Broadcasters, Inc. (“RPVB”), the licensee of Station KXLA(TV), Rancho Palos Verdes, California (the “Station”), acting pursuant to Section 2(b)(2) of the Commercial Advertisement Loudness Mitigation Act (“CALM Act”) and Paragraphs 52 and 53 and footnote 228 of the *Implementation of the Commercial Advertisement Loudness Mitigation (CALM) Act*, 26 FCC Rcd 17222 (2011) (“CALM Rules”), hereby certifies to the Federal Communications Commission that it is in need of a renewal of the one-year delay in its required compliance with the CALM Rules and seeks such relief pursuant to the streamlined rules adopted by the Commission. In support thereof, RPVB states as follows:

RPVB filed a timely request, on September 21, 2012, seeking a one-year delay in its compliance with the CALM Rules.

RPVB submits that it continues to meet the standard for being considered a “small broadcast station” for CALM Act and CALM Rules purposes. For calendar year 2012, the most recent full calendar year, the Station, an independent television station whose programming consists of primarily of foreign-language and religious programming, produced annual gross

programming consists of primarily of foreign-language and religious programming, produced annual gross revenue of less than \$14 million. Owing to the size of its annual gross revenue, the Station qualifies as a small business under relevant standards and meets the test established in the CALM Rules for treatment as a small broadcast station.

RPVB also submits that it needs the one-year delay in obtaining equipment in order to avoid the financial hardship that would be imposed were it required to obtain the equipment necessary to be in place as of the effective date of the CALM Rules. Attached hereto, as Exhibit A, is the equipment specifications received by RPVB in order to effect compliance with the CALM Act. The acquisition of this equipment constitutes a financial hardship given the annual gross revenues and expenses associated with operation of the Station. A renewal of the one-year delay in RPVB having to acquire this equipment represents a meaningful limitation on the financial hardship that the CALM Act imposes on the Station.

Consequently, RPVB is entitled to a renewal of the financial hardship waiver permitting it to receive a further one-year delay in its CALM Act and CALM Rules compliance.


