In accordance with the provisions of the FCC approved Region 19 Plan Update Committee (RPUC) is submitting the attached amendment to its frequency allocation table for your approval. The amendment represents changes made as a result of the Committees "Window Thirty Three" application process. The requested changes have been reviewed and approved by adjacent Region 8 and 30 (copies of those approvals are enclosed).

Approval of the proposed allocations of 806 MHz spectrum, as detailed in the attached document (original and 5 copies), entitled "Amendment to the Regional Public Safety Plan, Docket 90-53, New England Area – Region 19", sub-titled "Window Thirty Three Channel Allocations" is formally requested by this letter.

In order to expeditiously allocate spectrum to public safety organizations, the Region 19 Committee has set a very aggressive timetable. Hampden County Sheriff's Department is currently operational on VHF Wideband with a FCC waiver due to expire at the end of December 2013. We, The City of Providence Rhode Island Public Safety Communications Department have applied to operate an 800 MHz base station (mobile relay repeater) on 852.2875 MHz. We understand that you currently operate on adjacent 852.2750 MHz.

FCC rules provide for shared use of the frequency spectrum with nearby users and the procedures to follow. One of these procedures is to obtain a Letter of Concurrence (LOC) from a current licensed agency. Further, per FCC rules, a response to the request is required within 20 days of receipt of a request for concurrence. The response may be affirmative or negative.

Further, it is our understanding that should any interference problems arises as a result of The City of Providence Rhode Island Public Safety Communications Department using 852.2875 MHz that The City of Providence Rhode Island Public Safety Communications Department will take any and all responsibility for correcting the problems immediately. This responsibility would include any cost or actions necessary to correct the interference problem up to and including moving to a different frequency.




