
Dear Ms. Dortch:

This is to inform you that on September 18, 2013, Matthew Zinn, Senior Vice President, General Counsel, Secretary & Chief Privacy Officer, TiVo Inc. ("TiVo") and the undersigned met with Sarah Whitesell, Legal Advisor to Acting Chairwoman Mignon Clyburn, and Seth Williams, Intern in the Chairwoman's Office.

The purpose of these meetings was to discuss the Petition for Rulemaking filed by TiVo in CS Docket No. 97-80 and PP Docket No. 00-67 on July 16, 2013. We discussed the arguments set forth in the Petition for Rulemaking, and urged the Commission to act expeditiously in order to remove uncertainty regarding the Commission's CableCARD rules and provide consumers and retail manufacturers with certainty that navigation devices purchased at retail will continue to receive cable signals that consumers have subscribed to. We also discussed the need for a successor solution to assure the availability of bidirectional video signals to retail devices pursuant to Section 629, but emphasized that the CableCARD solution, which is fully realized today, must remain in place until a successor standard is in place.
