Dear Ms. Dortch;

We have been told that staff at the Commission is not allowed to download files from other sources. We have also been told that the FCC email system has a file size limit of 3 MB. Finally, we have been told that the Commission requires a financial disclosure when a fee waiver is requested, such showing to include tax returns for the previous year (2012). As Firweed has not yet prepared tax returns, we herewith include data from which tax returns are prepared. Enclosed you will find the Quickbooks backup file for Fireweed Communications LLC. The data spans the entire history of the company.

Staff has suggested sending the data on paper, but as this would require several reams of paper, and hugely more time for Firweed to send, and for the Commission staff to inspect, we suggest this is a far more practical method. Using this method, Fireweed makes a complete disclosure of its finances.

It may be that the Commission has no Quickbooks software available. We suggest that if a very small broadcast entity having less than \$500,000 annual gross total revenue can afford Quickbooks, a federal agency having responsibilities under the Regulatory Flexibility Act can just as well afford to own one copy of Quickbooks, thereby reducing our reporting burden (and making it 100% complete) as it reduces Commission work load.
