PURPOSE

This report provides our engineering evaluation of station WACP-DT, including our analysis of the Station's Noise Limited Service Contour and other issues related to the poor quality of the signal received at Armstrong Utilities, Inc.'s (Armstrong) cable television headend located near Oxford, PA.

This report describes our analysis and conclusions, and includes an NLSC map reflecting the WACP's actual antenna configuration. We also discuss the possible sources of significant interference with WACP's signal from other licensed spectrum users, which likely contributes to the poor quality signal at the Oxford headend.

OBJECTIVES

The analysis of station WACP-DT undertaken by the firm of Meintel, Sgrignoli, & Wallace, LLC (MSW) had two principal objectives:

The first objective was to develop an accurate Noise Limited Service Contour (NLSC) to determine whether WACP's NLSC covered Armstrong's Oxford headend and cable system service area. Previous signal measurements undertaken by Armstrong personnel combined with the poor quality signal received at the Oxford headend raised the question of whether the station's NLSC actually encompassed Armstrong's service area.

The second objective was to test the signal and evaluate possible sources of interference that could help explain the poor signal quality received at the Oxford headend. The poor quality of the signal received at the Oxford headend raised the question of the possibility of interference from other licensed spectrum users as well as general propagation of the Low-VHF DTV signal.

NOISE LIMITED CONTOUR PREDICTION


Analysis conducted by MSW revealed that the WACP-DT Noise Limited Contour does not, in fact, encompass the Armstrong Head-End location at Oxford, PA. Utilizing the azimuth pattern published by the manufacturer of the WACP-DT antenna (Jampro) model JHD-LV2 (3 around panel) a map as well as point-to-point terrain profile were generated using the FCC OET-69 prediction methodology.

Although, the FCC's CDBS (Consolidated Data Base System) lists the antenna parameters for WACP as being "omni," the antenna employed by WACP-DT does not exhibit a completely omni-directional azimuth pattern. The antenna is a panel type antenna which is comprised of many panels arranged around the tower faces as well as panels stacked vertically.

In the case at hand, the azimuth pattern of the transmitting antenna installed by WACP has several deep nulls that result from the combination of the panels in the array. In fact, the antenna has a deep null in its azimuth pattern in the direction of the Oxford, PA head-end. According to the manufacturer's data, the relative field in the direction of the Oxford, PA head-end location is approximately -3.33 dB below that of the peak ERP. This means that the ERP in the direction of the head-end of interest is only approximately 4.64 KW. The 28dB μ contour falls well short of the Oxford, PA head-end when taking into consideration WACP's actual ERP along the azimuth of interest.

Figure 1 on the following page depicts the stations NLSC using the actual transmitting antenna parameters.

Plots of the noise-limited service contour and terrain profile as well as the antenna pattern data are contained in **Appendix 1** of this report.

FIELD TESTS

FIELD TEST VEHICLE DESCRIPTION

Appendix 2 contains a picture of the MSW test van in **Figure A2-1**, and the van's electronic system block diagram of the reference test equipment used for measurements is illustrated in **Figure A2-2**. The test antenna was mounted on the pneumatic mast of the truck and was capable of being raised to 30' AGL and angularly rotated remotely from within the truck.

A GPS unit inside the truck was used to determine the exact location of each test site as well as its distance and bearing back to the transmitter site. The GPS coordinates also provided accurate location information for a computer mapping program in order to identify and plot exact test site locations for this report.

For the 30' AGL reception tests, a calibrated Low-VHF Dipole antenna (A.H. Systems model TV-1) was utilized for measurements. The antenna element lengths were set for channel 4 at 43 inches and the dipole antenna factor for channel 4 is published by A.H. Systems as 4.58 dB/m.

The *dipole factor* allows direct mathematical conversion between field strength (in dB μ V/m) and signal power (in dBm). This value is known for CH 4 (-106.99 dBm – dB μ V), and it was used, along with the antenna gain (in dBd), truck system gain (in dB), measured signal power level (in dBm in a 6 MHz bandwidth), and the selected variable attenuator value (in dB) to calculate the DTV field strengths at each test site. The *system gain* in the truck was made up of the coaxial download cable, the variable input attenuator, and the “works-in-a-drawer” (**WIAD**) RF amplifier system that included an internal 4-way splitter at its output for simultaneously feeding the incoming DTV signals to multiple receivers and a spectrum analyzer.

The system gain for the 30' AGL system was measured for calibration purposes before the start of the testing. The 30' AGL system had a net system gain of approximately 10.2 dB at Channel 4. By using the selected attenuator value (to provide not more than an *approximate* -50 dBm/6 MHz signal level at the spectrum analyzer input to minimize amplifier overload), the field strength was accurately calculated at each test site for the digital ATSC signal. The input attenuator also provided the means to determine the DTV site margin by attenuating the received signal to just above threshold of visible errors (**TOV**) and threshold of audible errors (**TOA**), a value that was determined by the truck's measured noise floor (and corrected for the spectrum analyzer's own measured noise floor) and found to have a value of approximately -89.1 dBm/6 MHz (as measurable by the spectrum analyzer).

The field test van utilizes two NTIA Certified Coupon Eligible Converter Boxes (CECB) for DTV receivers. This particular test utilized an LG and GE CECB. Each CECB is fed from an output from the WIAD Pre-amplifier system.

A Rhode & Schwarz FSH-3 Spectrum Analyzer is utilized for the measurement of the DTV signals, spectrum plots, and its internal tracking generator is used for system calibration purposes.

HEAD-END TESTS SYSTEM DESCRIPTION

For the Armstrong receive antenna system tests, the receive antenna utilized was a Scientific Atlanta model QCA 2-6 log periodic antenna (published gain 8.5dBi/5.85dBd) mounted at approximately 90 feet above ground level. This antenna was oriented toward the WACP-DT transmitter site location.

The coaxial download cable used was MC²-1G 0.650 cable. The download loss for this cable at 69MHz was approximately 0.57dB. In addition, a short RG-59 jumper cable was used to connect the 0.650 cable to the spectrum analyzer. This jumper cable had a loss of approximately 0.5113dB. The total coaxial line losses were approximately 1.08dB for channel 4.

This coaxial download was then connected to the Rhode & Schwarz FSH-3 spectrum analyzer for measurements of the DTV Signal and spectrum plots of the received signal.

After the received signal level measurements were completed, the cable was disconnected from the spectrum analyzer and was connected to the Tandberg RX8320 ATSC receiver for service availability and picture quality observations. It is noted that there were no additional components in the receive system signal chain (splitters, filters, etc.) for the headend tests.

FIELD TEST PLAN

The following text outlines the measurements undertaken at the Armstrong Cable location. MSW conducted these measurements on January 31, 2013. The field test followed the field testing methodology used in the past, including field work performed during the Grand Alliance tests in Charlotte, NC, the Model HDTV Station tests in Washington DC, and subsequent numerous field tests around the country performed by MSW as well as standard FCC Digital Television Measurement procedures.

MEASUREMENT OVERVIEW

For the field test MSW provided a field test plan and data spreadsheet, a senior engineer, reference test equipment and a fully-equipped test vehicle, measured data analysis, and a written report. In addition to the report, MSW archived all of test data and spreadsheet.

At the Oxford, PA head-end location, the measurements consisted of one measurement with the van receiving system with its antenna at 30 feet above ground level, as well as one test with the Armstrong Low-VHF receive antenna system with its antenna at 90 feet above ground level.

The van measurements utilized a calibrated dipole antenna was used to accurately measure the 6 MHz DTV signal of WACP-DT at 30' with the antenna adjusted for maximum field strength. The outside test measurements included field strength, service determination (picture quality), and service margin (if it existed).

The head-end measurements undertaken with the Armstrong receive antenna utilized a Scientific Atlanta Low-VHF log periodic antenna at approximately 90' with the antenna oriented toward WACP and adjusted for maximum signal level. These tests included signal level, service determination (picture quality), and service margin (if it existed).

MEASUREMENT PROCEDURES

The following is a description of the test procedures used to measure the WACP-DT signal.

Test Procedure

1. Confirm proper operation of the transmitter and field test van equipment (i.e., Calibration Tests).
 - a. Verify truck generator, mast, mast-mounted compass & camera, and GPS functionality.
 - b. Verify sufficient truck gas & tire tread, generator gas, truck and generator oil.
 - c. Verify and *record* truck system gain, in dB (antenna output to spectrum analyzer input).
 - d. Verify truck attenuator functionality, in dB (10 dB steps and 1 dB steps).
 - e. Verify and *record* truck noise floor, in dBm/6 MHz.
 - f. Verify proper operation of truck’s DTV receivers, monitors, and remote controls (use an existing DTV signal in the proper frequency band).

2. At the measurement test site, perform the following:
 - a. Confirm the feasibility of *safely* raising antenna to 30’ AGL in front of the test site without encountering obstructions such as tree limbs or overhead wires.
 - b. If the location is not suitable, move to closest suitable location.
 - c. When location is deemed suitable, place traffic cones to warn passing motorists.
 - d. Attach antenna to the pneumatic *mast*, connect it to mast’s coaxial feedline, and raise the antenna to 30’ AGL.
 - e. Employing GPS, determine exact coordinates of test site location, determine the distance and bearing to the transmitter. Record these results together with a description of the test site (including a street address, if possible, and nearby cross streets). Note and record weather conditions (temperature, sunny, cloudy, rain, fog, sleet, snow, etc.).
 - f. Record comments relative to any anomalous observations regarding the test site such as interference or other impairments.

- g. Orient antenna for maximum DTV signal strength as measured on the Spectrum Analyzer.
 - h. Perform **DTV** measurements on mast-mounted antenna:
 - i. Adjust input attenuator to achieve a RF system DTV output level of *about* -50 dBm/6 MHz. Verify and record input attenuator setting.
 - ii. Measure the *exact* average power in 6 MHz of the received DTV signal at the spectrum analyzer input. Note any RF signal level variations.
 - iii. Calculate DTV RMS field strength (in dB μ V/m/6 MHz) using truck system parameters (antenna gain, dipole factor, input attenuator, and RF system gain).
 - iv. Calculate SNR value using truck system parameters (signal power in 6 MHz, noise power in 6 MHz, input attenuator).
 - v. If service is available, increase input attenuator until just above TOV, and record the attenuator setting (i.e., site margin). Note any “hits” (i.e., burst errors).
3. Verify that all data is properly logged.

FIELD TEST RESULTS


GENERAL OVERVIEW

The summarized results of the measurements are presented below in **Table 1**. Included in the data is the received signal level (dBm); the calculated field strength (dB μ V/m); service availability (reception); and if there was reception the DTV receiver margin for Receiver #1 (RX1) and Receiver #2 (RX2).



The data in **Table 1** shows that the reception of the WACP-DT signal at the Armstrong head-end did not meet the FCC required -61.0dBm signal level for carriage. Also, the signal was not able to be received on the head-end DTV receiver and did not provide acceptable service or picture quality.

The measurement taken with the MSW Van measurement system also yielded a signal level from WACP-DT that was below the FCC required -61.0dBm level for carriage on the system. Reception on either of two DTV receivers in the MSW van also was not possible.



MSW Measurement Van Received Signal Level at Oxford Head-End


It was apparent during the measurements that a very strong carrier on the upper-adjacent band-edge was present at both head-end measurement locations (van and Armstrong antenna).

Using a spectrum analyzer in the demodulator mode, the carrier at 72.06MHz tuned and demodulated audio had the distinctive sound of low-rate data with periodic sync signals that would be consistent with a mobile-data service or paging service. (See Spectrum Plot in Upper Adjacent Interference Section below).

The spectrum between channels 4 and 5 is allocated for land-mobile use and has been used predominately for paging systems as well as mobile data services for Private Land-Mobile companies.

A subsequent search of FCC records determined that there are several licensed land-mobile operations in the upper-adjacent frequencies to WACP in the Oxford head-end area. Two specific licenses were identified as interference sources to the WACP signal in the vicinity of Oxford, PA. They are listed below in Table 2.

Due to the relatively high ERP's (300 watts and 150 watts) of these operations and their close proximity to the Oxford head-end, reception of the WACP-DT would be impaired even if the received signal level of WACP-DT were higher. The desired-to-undesired signal ratio (D/U) would preclude reception of the WACP-DT signal at the head-end. Thus, off-air reception of the WACP-DT signal is not possible at the Oxford, PA due to interference on the upper-adjacent channel.

UPPER ADJACENT CHANNEL INTERFERENCE

As mentioned previously, when measuring the WACP-DT signal, it was noted that a very strong carrier was present right at the upper channel edge. Further investigation revealed that there are multiple licensed land-mobile operations in the area licensed for 72.06 MHz.

As shown in the above spectrum plot, taken at the Oxford head-end location, the interfering upper adjacent channel carrier is more than ~35dB stronger than the desired DTV carrier. Given the carrier spacings traditional filtering techniques would not resolve or mitigate this interference.

The channel 4 upper band edge is 72 MHz. It is obvious that a strong signal only 60KHz away from the desired DTV signal would be problematic for any DTV receiver. Consequently, reception of the WACP-DT signal is severely impaired by the adjacent channel land-mobile signals.

Tests conducted at the ATTC (Advanced Television Test Center) during the ACATS (FCC Advisory Committee on Advanced Television Service) testing program as well as follow-up testing conducted by the ATTC related to land-mobile band-sharing indicated that strong adjacent narrow-band signals were problematic for DTV tuners with wide-band AGC and minimal filtering (No SAW filters are employed in today's modern DTV receivers as was the case for the prototype Grand-Alliance receiver).

Thus, even if the WACP-DT signal met the -61dBm criteria (which it does not) reception would not be possible due to the adjacent channel interference from land-mobile operations. Furthermore, given the close proximity of the land-mobile transmitter and the frequencies involved filtering or other mitigation is not likely to yield improved reception for WACP-DT.

LOW-VHF IMPULSE NOISE ISSUES

It is well-known that the RF "Noise Floor" in the Low-VHF band has been problematic for DTV reception for some time. Test conducted by this firm on several Low-VHF DTV stations documented much higher levels of impulse and electrical noise in the Low-VHF TV channels due to higher emissions from switching power supplies, television sets, computers, and other electronic devices.

Furthermore, noise from electrical lines and other sources have essentially created a scenario where reception on the Low-VHF channels requires a much higher signal level to overcome the impulse noise that has become prevalent in the band. Thus, it is not unexpected that reception of the channel 4 signal from WACP is not possible at signal levels near the threshold of the receiver (at and beyond the noise limited contour).

MULTIPLE IMPAIRMENTS

The WACP-DT signal suffers from multiple impairments. In addition to the very low received signal level, the upper-adjacent channel land-mobile interference, impulse noise and electrical noise in the Low-VHF band, as well as some multipath and other propagation conditions all couple together to create a signal that is not receivable due to the multiple impairments. Mitigating a single impairment (such as the upper adjacent channel interference) would likely not resolve the reception issues with WACP-DT as cumulative effects multiple impairments renders the WACP-DT unusable at the Oxford head-end location.

SUMMARY OF RESULTS

Noise Limited Service Contour

When actual WACP-DT antenna pattern and ERP are factored in, the WACP-DT noise limited 28dB μ contour does not encompass the Oxford headend or service area.

Signal Evaluation and Interference

Field tests showed that the received signal level at the Armstrong Head-End location was measured to be -66.6dBm. Service Availability and picture quality assessment was conducted using a Tandberg Model RX8320 ATSC receiver. No reception was possible of the WACP-DT signal even with the antenna directly connected to the receiver.

Additional measurements at the head-end location using the MSW van with an antenna at 30 Feet AGL yielded a signal level of -62.7dBm. Service availability and picture quality assessments were also conducted with this setup utilizing two different makes and models of DTV receivers. No reception was possible of the WACP-DT signal was possible.

Impairment to the WACP-DT signal is likely being caused by the very strong upper-adjacent land-mobile signal at 72.06 MHz. The interference from the land-mobile signal is precluding reception of the WACP-DT signal. In other words, even if the WACP-DT signal met the requirements for carriage, the impairments from nearby licensed land-mobile spectrum users would impair reception of WACP-DT.

Based upon our experience and knowledge of the ATSC transmission system and DTV receiver design, mitigation techniques such as filters, phased-antenna arrays, and others are not likely to resolve the interference due to the very narrow 60KHz spacing of the two RF signals.

Furthermore, given the ambient "RF Noise Floor" in the Low-VHF band, reception of the WACP-DT signal is further impaired by impulse and electrical noise that is prevalent in the Low-VHF television band.



(0.5 km Cells / 0.1 km terrain retrieval, LR error flags ignored)






APPENDIX 2

Figure A2-2 Armstrong Cable field test truck system block diagram




Figure A2-3 Armstrong Cable Head-End Receive System block diagram




Figure A3-1 Map of Land-Mobile Transmitter Location & Head-End

Qualifications of the Firm

Gary received his BSEE and MSEE degrees from the University of Illinois, and was a design engineer with Zenith Electronics Corporation in their Research and Development group for 27 years before leaving to become a DTV broadcast consulting engineer. In 2005, Gary merged his consulting practice (Sgrignoli Consulting) into the firm Meintel, Sgrignoli, & Wallace, where he is a partner and principal engineer.

Gary has worked in the R&D design area on television "ghost" canceling, cable TV scrambling, and cable TV two-way data systems before turning to digital television transmission systems. Since 1991, he has been extensively involved in the 8-VSB *digital* transmission system *design*, its prototype *implementation*, and its *lab* and *field* tests. He holds 35 U.S. patents (many related to DTV and 8-VSB transmission), is a recipient of the prestigious IEEE Matti S. Siukloa award, and was selected as SBE Educator of the Year for 2005.

Gary was involved with the DTV Station Project in Washington DC, helping to develop DTV RF test plans. He has also been involved with numerous television broadcast stations around the country, training them for DTV field testing and data analysis, and participated in numerous DTV over-the-air demonstrations with the Grand Alliance and the ATSC, both in the U.S. and abroad. In addition to

publishing technical papers and giving presentations at various conferences (NAB, BTS, ICCE, SBE), he has presented many VSB transmission system seminars around the country since 1998.


He has worked on the Broadcast side, as well, holding Chief Engineer and Operations Manager positions with both radio and television stations.

WACP Predicted Service Contour from FCC CDBS




