**Re: WT Docket No. 11-124; Modification to Associated Application**

Dear Ms. Scinto:

On August 9, 2013, Chevron USA Inc. ("Chevron") submitted a modification application to effectuate a move of the request for rule waiver previously filed under call sign WQHV 404 to call sign WQPK 756.

Chevron originally submitted the request for rule waiver for the company's nationwide 3650-3700 MHz license WQHV 404 on October 7, 2008. The waiver was subject to a Public Notice and comment period associated with this Wireless Telecommunications Bureau docket. At that time, station WQHV 404 was Chevron's only license for the 3650-3700 MHz band. Since the initial filing of this waiver request, for internal administrative reasons, Chevron obtained a license for station WQPK 756 to be used to register locations in the Gulf of Mexico and offshore Alaska.

Because the waiver request is in regards to Chevron's use of the 3.65 GHz band in the Gulf of Mexico and offshore portions of Alaska, Chevron filed a new modification application to re-associate the waiver request with station WQPK 756. Chevron has withdrawn the prior application filed for WQHV 404 identified by file number 0003602351.

Chevron confirms no substantive changes have been made to the waiver request and that this modification was submitted for administrative purposes only.
