***Request for Extension of Streamlined Financial Hardship Waiver  
Implementation of CALM Act***

Dear Ms. Dortch:

We are filing this request for a renewal of a waiver and certification on behalf of our client First Assembly of God of West Monroe (“FAWM”), the licensee of KMCT-TV in accordance with the waiver provisions of footnote 211 of the Report and Order, *In the Matter of the Implementation of the Commercial Advertisement Loudness Mitigation (CALM) Act*, 26 FCC Rcd 17222 (2011).

By this letter, we are formally requesting a one-year renewal of KMCT’s streamlined, financial hardship waiver of the CALM Act implementation deadline. As set forth in the Report and Order, a broadcast station is eligible for a renewal of its streamlined financial hardship waiver if it is still a small broadcast station and needs the further delay of the requirement to obtain the necessary equipment due to financial hardship. A “small station” for these purposes is defined as either a station with no more than \$14,000,000 in annual receipts or one that is located in any of the 150-210 television markets.

<sup>1</sup> Due to the lapse in government funding from October 1 through October 16, 2013, we were unable to make this filing. We are now filing this waiver request as of October 17, 2013 and consider it to be timely due to suspension of all deadlines during the shutdown.

We are enclosing a certificate executed by Darryl L. Minter, the secretary of FAWM, attesting to the fact that the station continues to meet the definition of a small station and that it needs a further delay of one year to purchase the necessary equipment due to financial hardship. We are also enclosing a quote from an equipment manufacturer detailing the specific equipment that FAWM intends to obtain.

We further understand that pursuant to the Report and Order, this waiver renewal request is considered to be automatically granted upon its submission and our receipt of an automatic "acknowledgment of receipt".
