***Request for Extension of Streamlined Financial Hardship Waiver
Implementation of CALM Act***

Dear Ms. Dortch,

We are filing this request for an extension of waiver and certification on behalf of our client Carolina Christian Broadcasting, Inc. (“CCB”), the licensee of WGGG-TV in accordance with the waiver extension provisions of footnote 21 of the Report and Order, *In the Matter of the Implementation of the Commercial Advertisement Loudness Mitigation (CALM) Act*, 26 FCC Rcd 17222 (2011).

By this letter, we are formally requesting an extension of CCB’s streamlined, financial hardship waiver of the CALM Act implementation deadline for one year for WGGG. As set forth in the Report and Order, a broadcast station is eligible for a streamlined financial hardship waiver extension if it is still a small broadcast station and continues to need the delay of the requirement to obtain the necessary equipment due to financial hardship. A “small station” for these purposes is defined as either a station with no more than \$14,000,000 in annual receipts or one that is located in any of the 150-210 television markets.

¹ Due to the lapse in government funding from October 1 through October 16, 2013, we were unable to make this filing. We are now filing this waiver request as of October 17, 2013 and consider it to be timely due to suspension of all deadlines during the shutdown.

We are enclosing a certificate executed by Dante Thompson, the president of CCB, attesting to the fact that the station meets the definition of a small station and that it needs an additional delay of one year to purchase the necessary equipment due to financial hardship. We are also enclosing an updated quote from an equipment manufacturer detailing the specific equipment that CCB intends to obtain.

We further understand that pursuant to the Report and Order, this waiver request is considered to be automatically granted upon its submission and our receipt of an automatic "acknowledgment of receipt".



1. I am the President of Carolina Christian Broadcasting, Inc., (“CCB”) the licensee of WGGG-TV, Greenville, SC. I have personal knowledge of the certifications made herein.
2. WGGG/CCB requires a waiver of the CALM Act rules implementation deadline of December 13, 2013, as extended by the waiver obtained by WGGG/CCB on October 11, 2012.
3. WGGG/CCB continues to meet the definition of a “small station” as set forth in paragraph 53 of the Report and Order, *In the Matter of the Implementation of the Commercial Advertisement Loudness Mitigation (CALM) Act*, 26 FCC Rcd 17222 (2011) for the purposes of determining eligibility for a waiver of the CALM Act rules.
4. WGGG/CCB needs a further delay of one year to avoid the financial hardship that would be imposed if it were required to obtain the equipment sooner due to the fact that WGGG/CCB has been upgrading its digital facilities and antenna at substantial cost.
5. WGGG/CCB is attaching to this certification a quote for all of the equipment that it will need to obtain for compliance with the CALM Act rules.
