Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to paragraph 103 of the *Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, Order, and Notice of Inquiry* issued in the above-captioned proceedings on April 18, 2013 (“Order”), Level 3 Communications, LLC (“Level 3”), on behalf of itself and its affiliates, WiTel Communications, LLC and Level 3 Communications Enhanced Services, LLC (“Level 3 ES”), hereby submits its second report on its numbering trial.

As of the date of this second report, Level 3 ES remains in the testing phase of its trial, and has not yet begun porting numbers or assigning new numbers to live customers. Accordingly, there is nothing yet to report for the categories identified by the Commission in paragraph 103 of the Order.<sup>1</sup>

All trial-related telephone numbers and LRNs are now LERG effective. To date, Level 3 ES has successfully completed initial testing for call routing in the Boston, Charlotte, Dallas, and

<sup>1</sup> The required reporting categories are: (1) the total of new numbers placed in service; (2) the total number of port-in requests (including existing and new customers); (3) the number of requests to port out from Level 3 ES a number it holds directly rather than through a CLEC partner, and the percentage of successful ports-out; (4) the total number of routing failures, along with the causes of those failures; and (5) a description of any billing or compensation disputes.

Los Angeles rate centers. Level 3 ES expects to conclude testing and begin porting numbers in these rate centers during the next reporting period.

As of the date of this report, initial testing in the Rochester and Denver has not been completed, and Level 3 personnel are in communication with personnel from the incumbent carriers serving those areas.
