REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF WAIVER DUE TO FINANCIAL HARDSHIP

Free Life Ministries, Inc. (“Free Life”), the licensee of Station WHFL-CD, Goldsboro, North Carolina, hereby requests an extension of the waiver of the effective date of the Commission’s Rules implementing the Commercial Advertisement Loudness Mitigation Act (“CALM Act”) pursuant to Paragraphs 52 and 53 of the *Implementation of the Commercial Advertisement Loudness Mitigation (CALM) Act*, 26 FCC Rcd 17222 (2011) (“Calm Rules”).¹ Free Life hereby certifies that it is in need of the one year extension in its required compliance with the CALM Act and the CALM Rules and seeks such relief pursuant to the streamlined rules adopted by the Commission. In support thereof, the following is respectfully submitted:

A small station may seek waiver of the Calm Rules by certifying to the Commission that it: (1) meets the Commission definition of a small business for this purpose and (2) needs a delay of one year to obtain specified equipment in order to avoid the financial hardship that would be imposed if it were required to obtain the equipment sooner. The Commission defines a “small station” as either a station with no more than \$14.0 million in annual receipts or that is located in television markets 150 to 210.

¹ The Commission suspended all FCC filing deadlines that occurred during the government shutdown and on or before October 21, 2013. See *Public Notice DA 13-2025* released October 17, 2013. Thus this pleading is timely filed.

Free Life submits that it meets the standard for being considered a small broadcast station under the Calm Rules. Free Life is an independent television station that broadcasts religious and community-oriented programming to its local viewers in Goldsboro, North Carolina. During the calendar year 2012, Free Life had less than \$14 million in annual receipts. Free Life anticipates that it will have less than \$14 million in annual receipts for both the 2013 and 2014 calendar years.


Free Life also submits that it needs a one-year delay in obtaining equipment in order to avoid the financial hardship that would be imposed were it required to obtain the equipment by the December 13, 2013 effective date of the Calm Rules. Attached hereto as Exhibit 1 is an estimated provided by SCMS, Inc. of the equipment WHFL-CD requires in order to comply with the Calm Rules. The acquisition of this equipment constitutes a financial hardship given the annual gross revenues and expenses associated with operation of WHFL-CD. A one year delay in Free Life having to acquire this equipment represents a meaningful limitation on the financial hardship that the CALM Act imposes on the station.

Consequently, WHFL is entitled to a financial hardship waiver permitting it to receive a one year extension in its CALM ACT and Calm Rules compliance.
