STREAMLINED FINANCIAL HARDSHIP WAIVER CERTIFICATION

KDMI License, LLC (“Pappas Telecasting”), licensee of KDMI-TV, Des Moines, Iowa (Facility ID No. 78915), hereby certifies that it requires an additional one-year delay to achieve compliance with the requirements of the Commercial Loudness Mitigation Act (the “CALM Act”) and, as set forth herein, requests waiver of the December 13, 2012 deadline for compliance. Pursuant to the streamlined waiver process set forth in the Commission’s December 13, 2011 *Report and Order* in this proceeding, Pappas Telecasting requests waiver for KDMI-TV as a “small broadcast station.”¹ Under the procedures adopted in the *Order*, a “small broadcast station” seeking a waiver must do so by certifying to the Commission that it qualifies as a “small broadcast station” and that it requires a delay of one year to obtain specified equipment to avoid financial hardship.²

As set forth in the attached Certification of Alice Heiserman, KDMI-TV certifies that it satisfies the definition of “small broadcast station” set forth in the *Order* by virtue of the fact that the station has less than \$14 million in annual receipts. KDMI-TV further certifies that to avoid

financial hardship, it requires an additional one-year delay to obtain certain specified equipment, as listed on Exhibit 1, necessary for KDMI-TV to comply with the Commission's CALM Act requirements.

Additionally, the equipment which KDMI-TV plans to implement to become compliant with the CALM Act requirements is the Volicon TS Observer with the CALM module (or equivalent).

For the foregoing reasons, Pappas Telecasting respectfully requests an additional one-year waiver for KDMI-TV to comply with the CALM Act.

CERTIFICATION OF ALICE HEISERMAN

I, Alice Heiserman, hereby certify as follows:

1. I am General Ledger Accountant of KDMI License, LLC, licensee of television station KDMI-TV, Des Moines, Iowa.
2. During each calendar year 2011 and 2012, KDMI-TV had less than \$14 million in annual receipts. It is anticipated that the station will also have less than \$14 million in annual receipts for 2013.
3. To achieve compliance with the Commission's CALM Act requirements at KDMI-TV, Pappas Telecasting must obtain and implement the Volicon TS Observer with the CALM module (or equivalent).
4. To avoid financial hardship, Pappas Telecasting requires an additional one-year waiver of the Commission's CALM Act requirements to allow it to obtain the necessary equipment for KDMI-TV.
