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Our large urban District relies heavily on E-Rate funding. We would not be able to afford telecommunication services, including internet, without E-Rate funding. Even with E-Rate funding, it is extremely difficult. In addition to Priority One, we're in urgent need of Priority Two funding in order to prepare for upcoming mandated online testing. Our District has embraced technology integration into every aspect of teaching and learning, however the ability to keep up with evolving changes is severely limited by available funding. A beneficial improvement would be the simplification and streamlining of the entire process, as well as anything that could speed up the entire time frame. It would also be of great benefit if E-Rate funding was not so strictly limited and could be used for classroom technology tools such as student computers, etc.
