Subject: Appeal of USAC Funding Decision - Docket 02-6

Request for Review

We would like to appeal the decision by USAC to rescind for FRNs 2166385, 2166386, 2166387, 2166389, 2166394, 2166395, 2166396 and 2166398 of form 471 # 799803, Name of school: Project Social Care.

On the Notification of Commitment Adjustment Letter dated July 23, 2013 it states: After a thorough review, it was determined that the funding commitment for this request. must be rescinded in full. During a review, it was determined that funding was provided for the following ineligible items: Redundant Bogen Quantum Multicom equipment unit.

We are appealing this decision because we believe the Bogen system is not redundant, rather is was set up to work in combination with the primary PBX. The primary PBX provides the capability multiline telephone instruments, PRI or SIP Trunks and voicemail . However the areas of the school or library that are best served by standard analog telephone service such as class rooms are served with the Bogen expansion. The Bogen System and the primary PBX are integrated as one system. The cost of utilizing the two systems will typically be similar to the cost of adding the additional capacity to the primary PBX.

Additionally, it seems that when USAC approved the Bogen systems they were aware that the we are using a Bogen system in combination with our standard PBX. It seems that USAC had changed their own rules after the Bogen was approved and installed.
