Dear Ms. Dortch:

On November 4, 2013, Ethan Lucarelli, of Wiley Rein LLP, counsel to Puerto Rico Telephone Company, Inc. (“PRT”), spoke with Katie King, Senior Attorney Advisor, of the Wireline Competition Bureau (“Bureau”) regarding PRT’s October 30, 2013 filing in the above-captioned proceedings.¹ On the call, Ms. King asked PRT to supplement its filing with data about the actual current plant mix deployed today in PRT’s network.

The actual plant mix deployed today in PRT’s network may not be indicative of the future mix of a largely fiber-based broadband network deployed pursuant to Connect America Fund Phase II funding. PRT has previously provided forward-looking plant mix data that it believes best represents the likely future deployment scenario for PRT’s network and accounts for the unique circumstances of deploying fiber in Puerto Rico.² However, in response to the request from the Bureau, PRT provides the attached table summarizing the most currently available data on the actual plant mix of PRT’s network.
