Dear Ms. Dortch:

This is to notify you that on November 5, Julie Kearney, Vice President, Regulatory Affairs, Brian Markwalter, Sr. Vice President, Research & Standards, and Alex Reynolds, Sr. Manager and Regulatory Counsel, all of the Consumer Electronics Association (“CEA”), met with Julius Knapp, Chief Engineer, Office of Engineering and Technology (“OET”), as well as Matthew Hussey, Geraldine Matise, Rashmi Doshi, William Hurst, Mark Settle, and Mark Neumann of OET, and Robert Pavlak of the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau.

Consistent with its earlier comments in this proceeding,¹ CEA expressed its support for the FCC Technological Advisory Council (“TAC”) White Paper’s recommendation that the Commission adopt harm claim thresholds to improve receiver tolerance to interfering signals.² CEA representatives offered to assist the Commission as it evaluates the TAC’s recommendation and comments thereto, including by convening interested parties for stakeholder meetings.
