Representatives from South Park, L.L.C. dba South Park Telephone Company (“South Park”) held a conference call with Wire Competition Bureau (“Bureau”) staff on November 13, 2013. South Park representatives included David Shipley of South Park, Jovanka Mersman of Signal Telcom Partners, and Douglas Meredith, John Kuykendall and Cassandra Heyne of JSI. Bureau staff who participated in the call were Jodie May, Dennis Johnson, Chin Yoo, and Erin Boone.

The subject of discussion was the pending South Park petition for waiver of high-cost universal service rules filed November 27, 2012¹ and the subsequent filing on September 20, 2013 of a domestic Section 214 application for transfer of control for South Park and affiliated companies.² Discussion was held on the impact of the Section 214 Application on the pending Petition for Waiver, as well as the impact of the Petition for Waiver on the pending Section 214 Application.
