On November 13, 2013, Tamara Preiss and Patrick Welsh of Verizon, Steve Sharkey and John Hunter of T-Mobile USA, and Neeti Tandon and Stacey Black of AT&T met with John Leibovitz, Janet Young, Peter Daranco, Brian Regan, Blaise Scinto and Nancy Zaczek of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau and Julie Knapp, Mark Settle, Garth Hahn, and Michael Ha of the Office of Engineering and Technology.

We discussed the progress that has been made with the Department of Defense (DoD) on clearing and relocating out of the 1755-1780 MHz band, including the execution of a Memorandum of Understanding, spectrum monitoring tests, and the recent proposal to truncate and relocate DoD systems in order to make the band available for auction and commercial wireless use. We also discussed the additional bands included in the above-referenced AWS-3 proceeding and their potential pairings.
