The urban based health care providers are they non-profit or for profit?

Urban based clinics are required by the order to fit into one of the entity types designated by rule 54.600 of The Order which states;

A "health care provider" is any:

- (1) Post-secondary educational institution offering health care instruction, including a teaching hospital or medical school;
- (2) Community health center or health center providing health care to migrants;
- (3) Local health department or agency;
- (4) Community mental health center;
- (5) Not-for-profit hospital;
- (6) Rural health clinic;

The drop down selection that best suits your urban based clinics would be selection (2) community health center, unless the urban health care providers are not-for profit, then you can select option (5) not for profit.
