**REQUEST FOR FINANCIAL HARDSHIP WAIVER
FOR A SMALL BROADCAST STATION**

KWHY-22 Broadcasting, LLC (“KWHY”), the licensee of KWHY-TV, Los Angeles, California (Facility ID No. 26231)(the “Station”), hereby requests an extension of its waiver of the effective date of the rules implementing the Commercial Advertisement Loudness Mitigation Act (the “CALM Act”).

In the Implementation of the Commercial Advertisement Loudness Mitigation (CALM) Act, 26 FCC Rcd 17222 (2011)(“CALM Rules”), the Commission adopted a streamlined procedure for small stations to seek a one year waiver of compliance with the CALM Rules based on financial hardship. The CALM Rules permits a renewal of the waiver for one additional year.


KWHY hereby certifies that it is eligible for the streamlined waiver set forth in paragraph 52 and 53, and is eligible for an extension of the waiver as set forth in footnote 211 in paragraph 53. The Station’s annual gross receipts total less than \$14 million. Therefore, the Station qualifies as a “small broadcast station.” Current financial

circumstances continue to prevent KWHY from obtaining the necessary and specified equipment required for compliance with the CALM Act.

Based on the forgoing, KWHY respectfully requests a one-year extension of its waiver of the obligation to comply with the CALM act.
