

Dear Commissioner Pai:

My name is Robert Lloyd, I am the Executive Director of Long Island Citizens for Community Values (LICCV). LICCV is an alliance of concerned citizens including civic, business, religious and health care organizations. Our mission is to significantly reduce sexual violence and the victimization of children, women, and families by educating the citizens and legislators in the Long Island Metropolitan area as to the harmful effects of crimes associated with pornography.

The purpose of my letter is to inform you of my disappointment in the FCC considering allowing nudity and profanity on television before 8pm when young children will be watching. If this new regulation takes effect it will have a devastating impact on young children. We stand with the 75% of families who are against this change being made but the pressure from Hollywood is overriding popular opinion.

As I travel around the country speaking to thousands in schools, civic groups and legislature, I get the same response – the citizens are outraged and want to see something done.
