Cessna Aircraft Company	Propose Rules Section 3.	<p>Requirement that "...Existing ELTs that operate only on frequency 121.5 MHz must be operated as certified." still allows existing 121.5 MHz equipment to be transferred from one aircraft to another.</p> <p>14CFR91.207(1)(a) requires that "...after June 21, 1995, an emergency locator transmitter that meets the requirements of TSO-C91 may not be used for new installations." This may be interpreted to allow replacement of existing 121.5 MHz only equipment on an in-service aircraft.</p>	<p>Change text to read: <i>"...Existing ELTs that operate only on frequency 121.5 MHz must be operated as certified, and only on the aircraft at which they were installed beginning [ONE YEAR AFTER EFFECTIVE DATE]."</i></p>
