On December 2, 2013, James Arden Barnett, Jr. and Frederick M. Joyce of the law firm Venable LLP, attorneys representing TruePosition, Inc., a member of the Find Me 911 Coalition, met with Rear Admiral David Simpson, Chief of the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau ("PSHSB") and David Furth, Deputy Bureau Chief of PSHSB, at the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC").

The meeting was convened on behalf of TruePosition, Inc. to discuss the results of the recent FCC E911 Location Accuracy Workshop. Specifically, participants discussed the need to expeditiously move forward with a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking for technology-neutral indoor location requirements. Mr. Barnett and Mr. Joyce stressed that new requirements are the optimal way to address the public safety concerns raised at the workshop regarding the need to improve indoor location accuracy and the need to deliver accurate locations more quickly than can be achieved by Assisted GPS technology alone.
