I am in favor RM-11708. The Amateur Radio Digital modes are mature as a result of nearly 15 years of usage, and have developed into basically two types of modes. The first type are the narrow band modes such as PSK-31. These modes are essentially unaffected by RM-11708. The second type are the wide band modes with bandwidths of 2.8 KHz. Currently, these modes are governed by rules for RTTY, which are inadequate. They should be governed by a bandwidth rule, as that is their principal characteristic and their effect on other users in the Amateur radio bands.
