I support the three points below and hope the Commission will rapidly permit the use of PACTOR 4 and allow further improvements. Having been able to use this technology outside of the US, their benefits are immediately obvious.

1. The proposed change does not alter the bandwidth limits or the frequencies available for digital use, so no new frequency space is being used. It has no negative impact on the Ham spectrum.
2. The use of Pactor 4 simply makes the use of existing bandwidth more efficient, so additional traffic can be passed without allocating new frequencies.
3. The further development of even faster protocols in the same bandwidth limitations depends on the success of this rulemaking.
