I would like add my support to the proposed petition. As a more recent amateur radio operator (licensed in 2011), I find that some of the current outdated limitations limit my ability to efficiently utilize the available bandwidth. I fully support the removal of symbol rate in the current Rules since such a terminology is quite frankly outdated. I further support being able to use as much as 2.8kHz bandwidth in all frequencies below 29.7MHz authorized in the Amateur Radio Service. This petition further opens up additional amateur support for emergency communications support by allowing some of the newer and more efficient modulation formats currently limited to the US government. Amateur radio is still an important and vital component to emergency services in the USA and this petition will permit the Amateur Radio Service to stay current with other emergency formats in use today.
