I am writing to you to request your support for Globalstar's continued provision of SPOT services.

Todd's accident happened in September 2010. He was elk hunting in the Frank Church Wilderness when his horse lost his footing. Todd jumped off and landed in the same spot his horse fell, ultimately leading him to break his pelvis. Todd was 92 miles away from the closest paved road and thus his hunting partner activated the SPOT to send for help. The GEOS International Emergency Rescue Coordination Center contacted the Life Flight Network and they went after Todd. He was airlifted to a hospital and today, has made a full recovery. He is alive because of SPOT.

Since Todd was rescued, he has spoken to numerous outdoor groups like Back Country Horseman of Washington (BCHW), Cabelas, Church Wild Game Dinner, Boy Scout Groups, among others. Anytime we get the opportunity we tell someone about SPOT, we do and in fact, know of two more people who have

had their lives saved after we recommended SPOT to them.  
Thank you for your continued efforts to make life-saving  
technology like SPOT available.
