On December 9, 2013, Austin Schlick, Dr. Preston Marshall, and I met with Navid Golshahi and Robert Pavlak of the Office of Engineering and Technology and Kamran Etemad of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. Consistent with our Comments on the Proposed Revised Framework, we reiterated that Priority Access License (PAL) areas should reflect interference protection requirements¹ and that the FCC should avoid and resolve mutually exclusive PAL applications for commercial operations in the 3.5 GHz band.²
