Dear Ms. Dortch:

On December 9, 2013, David L. Cohen, Executive Vice President of Comcast Corporation (“Comcast”), Meredith Attwell Baker, Senior Vice President of Government Affairs, NBCUniversal Media, LLC (“NBCUniversal”), and the undersigned met with Commissioner Michael O’Rielly and his Legal Advisor, Erin McGrath, to discuss various issues of general interest to Comcast and NBCUniversal. During our meeting, Mr. Cohen referenced the *Clarification Order* issued by the Media Bureau in the above-captioned proceeding and under review by the Commission.¹ Specifically, he explained that, in order to comply with the Benchmark Condition,² NBCUniversal needs reasonable access to peer deals in order to avoid forcing parties into costly and burdensome arbitration.
