I strongly support allowing use of the Pactor 4 protocol for use on the amateur radio bands. As a boater who from time to time sails to remote locations, email via SSB radio is sometimes my only option. When we are underway, it we are often short-handed, and when reception is not ideal, we must have one person hand steer while the other does the communication. Pactor 4 is twice as fast as Pactor 3. We value that extra speed to minimize the communication time and also free up the frequency as soon as possible for use by others. Since Pactor 4 does not increase bandwidth requirements, I can only see benefits for its use.
