

RE: FCC Form 481 Data and High Cost ETC Affidavit – Supplemental Information

Dear Ms. Williams:

On October 15, 2013, Taconic Telephone Corp., d/b/a FairPoint Communications filed FCC Form 481 and supporting documentation for Taconic Telephone Company d/b/a FairPoint Communications as filed with the Universal Service Administrative Company for its study area in Massachusetts (SAC 150084). At the appropriate time due to the Government Shut-down, this information was also filed with the FCC.

Taconic Telephone Corp. d/b/a FairPoint Communications has an extremely small footprint in the state of Massachusetts and the customers are served from our New York facilities. As such, we do not have more detailed state specific information to file with either USAC or the FCC. The USAC/FCC requirements are by study area and our filing is consistent with FCC rules.

To address the request made on November 19, 2013, Taconic submits the following additional information. The affidavit requested was an oversight and has been included as an attachment to this letter.

1. Service Quality Standards – see attached statement of compliance, specific to Massachusetts.
2. Functionality in Emergency Situations – the document attached to the initial Form 481 filing for SAC #150084 is applicable to all customers in FairPoint's service footprint. I have attached it again for your convenience. Additionally, the contact information for Steve Staffier has been provided to our Corporate Risk Management department.
3. Terms and Conditions for Lifeline Customers – this information was provided as the final two pages of the information submitted on October 15. While we did include pages from the Taconic New York tariff, the appropriate pages from the MDTC tariff are also included. I have reattached them to this letter for your convenience.



On behalf of Richmond Telephone included here is a revised copy of the company's Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") Form 481. This filing updates the one previously filed to address issues raised by the Department in their November 19th letter. Specifically, the filing revises the descriptors associated with compliance to Service Quality Standards and Functionality in Emergency Situations (Lines 510 and 610, respectively) and provides documentation concerning the Company's provision of Lifeline services (Line 1200) that was previously incorrectly referenced.

This filing was certified and resubmitted to USAC today and is being concurrently filed with the FCC electronically with physical submission of confidential data set for delivery on December 10th.

Because the company believes its financial data is confidential and would cause competitive harm were it to be publically released, in addition to its public filing of this form, the company is requesting that the financial data submitted here be afforded confidential treatment pursuant to its request for confidential motion pursuant to G. L. c. 25C, § 5 previously submitted on October 14, 2013.



Pursuant to the Department's Notice, dated November 19, 2013, regarding Granby Telephone LLC d/b/a OTT Communications' ("Granby") submission of FCC Form 481 Data, enclosed please find an original and twelve (12) copies of Granby's revisions to Form 481, which was re-filed with the Universal Service Administrative Company ("USAC") and the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") on December 3, 2013.

Granby, as advised by Staff, amended the attachment for Box 510, "*Service Quality Standards and Consumer Protection Rules Compliance*," to include a territory specific description of Granby's compliance with Massachusetts' regulations and rules for consumer protection. In addition, Granby also amended Box 610, "*Functionality in Emergency Situations*," to outline Granby's emergency protocols, contacts in Massachusetts, and a detailed description of its abilities to function in emergencies.

In addition, as requested, Granby is enclosing a copy of Section 1200 that clearly states the website address in its entirety. The link brings you directly to Granby's rates. The terms and conditions for Lifeline consumers can be found by going to the Residential tab at the top of the screen and selecting "Lifeline Discounted Service." Also enclosed, please find a copy of the referenced attachment, 110036ma1210, which states "Line 1210 should not have a document attached."

Granby did not certify or respond to the questions involving Section 3000 of Form 481 because it is not a privately held carrier; it is a publicly held carrier. Therefore, the section was not required to be filled out for the program year 2014.
