Dear Ms. Dortch:

On December 16, 2013, Lydia Runnels, Vice President, Product Development and Engineering, and the undersigned of CSDVRS, LLC (“ZVRS”) met with Henning Schulzrinne, Chief Technology Officer, and Gregory Hlibok, Chief, Elaine Gardner and Caitlin Vogus, Attorney Advisors, Disability Rights Office. Ms. Runnels discussed the technical feasibility of engineering the interoperability of video mail for both video relay services (“VRS”) and point to point video calls. Ms. Runnels also provided information regarding engineering the portability of the address book. Consistent with ZVRS’ oft-expressed comments to the Commission, Ms. Runnels established that interoperable video mail and portable address book can be accomplished by all providers in very short order without requiring significant funding. These functions can be accomplished without needing to wait for an indeterminate period to establish industry standards. It was pointed out that the current lack of interoperable video mail has posed a definitive risk to the health and safety of consumers and their families; an actual example was provided where the administrators for a school for the deaf using ZVRS videophones could not leave video mail for parents of students regarding emergencies.
