NOTICE OF RELINQUISHMENT OF ETC DESIGNATION

In its July 25, 2012 Order in Docket No. 2012-133-C, the Commission designated Allied Wireless of the Palmetto State, LLC d/b/a U-Lifeline Wireless (“ULW”) as an eligible telecommunications carrier (“ETC”) for the limited purpose of providing Lifeline service to qualifying households over its own facilities. On September 20, 2013, the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) approved AT&T Inc.’s acquisition of the wireless assets of Atlantic Tele-Network, Inc., including its affiliate ULW,¹ and on September 23, 2013, ULW merged with and into New Cingular Wireless PSC, LLC d/b/a AT&T Mobility (“AT&T Mobility”). Neither of these transactions involving wireless carriers required review or approval by this Commission. *See* S.C. Code Ann. §58-11-100(B).


In light of these developments, and as the AT&T entity holding the assets of the former ULW, AT&T Mobility hereby notifies the Commission of the relinquishment of ULW’s ETC Designation effective September 23, 2013.²

As noted in the FCC's Approval Order, AT&T Mobility is taking steps to ensure that the transition from ULW to AT&T Mobility is a smooth one for Lifeline customers.³ Initially, ULW's Lifeline customers will continue to use their CDMA phones as they did before the transaction.⁴ They will be transitioned to a comparable CDMA post-paid plan with a price substantially similar to their prepaid CDMA ULW Lifeline plan. After AT&T Mobility completes the upgrades of ULW's network assets from CDMA to GSM technology, these customers will be transitioned to a comparable post-paid AT&T Mobility 3G plan, with a price substantially similar to the customer's original Lifeline plan and with a comparable device pre-selected by AT&T and provided to the customer at no charge. Prior to this transition, ULW's Lifeline customers can terminate service at any time with no early termination fee so they can consider alternative Lifeline service providers.



⁴ In the transaction the FCC approved, AT&T Mobility acquired, among other things, network assets that ULW operated using CDMA technology. AT&T Mobility's network uses a different technology, GSM. Accordingly, AT&T Mobility will upgrade and incorporate ULW's CDMA network assets into its GSM network over time.
