Dear Ms. Dortch:

On December 19, 2013, Michael K. Powell, President & CEO of the National Cable & Telecommunications Association, David Cohen, Executive Vice President of Comcast Corporation, and (participating by telephone) James W. Cicconi, Senior Executive Vice President of AT&T, met with Philip Verveer, Senior Counselor to the Chairman, and Stephanie Weiner, Associate General Counsel, to discuss the pending judicial review of the Commission's "Open Internet" rules.

Messrs. Powell, Cohen and Cicconi noted that any discussion of specifics was premature, given that the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit has not yet issued a decision in the case. They did note, however, that regardless of how the case comes out, the principles articulated by the Commission enjoy widespread support and broadband customers will continue to enjoy unfettered access to Internet content and applications.¹
