On April 23, 2013, on behalf of Blue Ridge Cable Technologies, Inc., ("Blue Ridge"), you filed a Petition for Special Relief requesting the Commission to exclude for must carry purposes, twelve Pennsylvania communities served by two Blue Ridge cable systems from the television market of Station WACP, Atlantic City, NJ ("WACP").

Subsequently, on July 3, 2013, you informed the Commission that Blue Ridge requests that its Petition be dismissed without prejudice because the parties have reached an agreement regarding carriage of WACP.
