RE: WT Docket No. 13-293; *In the Matter of Kentucky Hearing and Telephone Corporation and Florida Hearing and Telephone Corporation – Applications Pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Section 63.04 of the Commission’s Rules for Approval of the Transfer of Control of a Domestic Interstate Carrier.*

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Upon conferral with Wireline Competition Bureau staff, and pursuant to their request, I am filing this letter to supplement the above-listed applications to provide further information on two matters.

(1) Florida Hearing and Telephone is certificated as a competitive local exchange carrier (“CLEC”) in Florida and is therefore authorized to provide service throughout the State of Florida. Florida Hearing and Telephone does not currently provide service to any consumers, but its authorized service territory is the entire State of Florida. Similarly, Kentucky Hearing and Telephone is certificated as a CLEC in Kentucky and is therefore authorized to provide service throughout the Commonwealth of Kentucky. Kentucky Hearing and Telephone does not currently provide service to any consumers, but its authorized service territory is the entire Commonwealth of Kentucky.

(2) Glenda Sue Harvison does not presently hold a ten percent or greater ownership interest in any domestic telecommunications carriers. Mrs. Harvison, however, does hold a 100 percent ownership interest in a company named GS Texas Ventures, LLC, which has applied for certification as a CLEC in the State of Texas.¹ That application is currently pending, but, upon approval, GS Texas Ventures, LLC intends to offer telephone exchange and exchange access services throughout the State of Texas. Mrs. Harvison also holds a 100 percent ownership interest in a company named GS Iowa Ventures, LLC, which is in the process of obtaining an Iowa incumbent local exchange carrier named Reasnor Telephone Company. That purchase has not yet closed because regulatory approval has not yet been secured. Upon transfer of Reasnor Telephone Company, Mrs. Harvison will hold a 100 percent ownership interest in the carrier’s

parent. Reasnor Telephone Company provides telephone exchange and exchange access services within the Reasnor exchange of Iowa.
